Craft Contemporary: Visitor Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in visiting Craft Contemporary! To ensure that your visit is enjoyable for everyone, we kindly ask you to read our guidelines below.

A Welcoming Space: Our museum is a space for discovering something new and sharing an experience with family and friends. Any behavior or activity that disrupts the safe or orderly use of the museum, or that affects the staff's ability to provide services, is prohibited — no profanity and/or engaging in rude, inconsiderate, or abusive behavior. We ask you to embrace empathy and care by treating fellow visitors, staff, and artists with kindness, understanding, and respect.

Keep It Serene: We want everyone to immerse themselves in the gallery experience, so please keep noise levels at a considerate level. If you have electronic devices with sound, such as phones, we kindly ask you to turn off the volume. You can take phone calls in the museum's courtyard if necessary.

Family-Friendly Environment: Families are an essential part of our community, and we welcome strollers, breastfeeding, and bottle-feeding in all public museum spaces. Please remember that children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Art Safety: For your safety and to protect the artwork on view, please honor all gallery barriers and keep a distance of at least 3 ft from the artwork. We ask that you please refrain from touching the exhibits or lean on walls and pedestals.

Animals: To ensure everyone's comfort and safety, we ask that you leave animals at home. Trained service animals following ADA compliance are welcome if they are on a leash and under their owner's control as authorized by applicable law.

Oversized Items and Baggage: Due to artwork safety, we ask you to please leave oversized, or potentially hazardous materials and baggage at home. Large bags, scooters, skateboards, and other oversized items are not allowed in the museum galleries or shop and must be left outside or held at the front desk.

Refreshments: There is no food or drink allowed in the museum galleries to protect the artwork on view and keep the museum clean. Bottled water is permitted in our galleries and shop as long as the lid is tightly sealed.

Capturing Memories: Do snap photos and videos during your museum adventure for personal, noncommercial use. Please turn off flash and leave selfie sticks at home as they can lead to accidents and damaged artwork. Be sure to share your favorite moments on social media and tag us @craftcontemporary.
